A. SUMMARY

1. Supporting devices for electrical components.
2. Concrete equipment bases.
3. Electrical identification.

B. MATERIALS

1. Supporting Devices:
 - a. Steel channel and angles, galvanized for outdoors and damp locations.
 - b. Nonmetallic channel and angles.
 - c. Damp Locations and Outdoors: Metal or nonmetallic channel.
 - d. Dry Locations: Steel channel.
2. Identification Materials:
 - a. Raceway and Cable Labels: Adhesive vinyl.
 - b. Underground Line Warning Tape: Colored plastic.
 - c. Signs and Instruction Plates: Engraved plastic.

C. DEMOLITION

1. Exposed Abandoned Electrical Work: Removed.
2. Buried Raceway and Wiring Abandoned in Place: Cut and removed 2 inches (50 mm) below surface.
3. Cut and patch for electrical work.
